Overview:

Ireland and Northern Ireland have long been the meeting place of two distinct cultural groups, the native Irish people and the newer Anglo-Saxons. Due to historical coincidence, one group was Catholic and the other, Protestant. Due to the long history of political unrest, religion in Ireland and Northern Ireland is a sensitive issue that must be approached with care. The widespread secularism of Europe is taking hold in Ireland, so

they need people willing to share the Gospel. The Irish are reserved and skeptical, but willing to listen and form friendships.

Ministry Description:

In Northern Ireland, your team will support the ministry of the Murlough House, a center of evangelistic outreach for 42 years in the community. In Ireland, you will work with missionaries with 20+ years of experience in their area. You will use various tools to share Christ during your stay: everything from sports camps to children's programs, to putting on a community activity. Your team will have a chance to encourage the local church by helping to deepen relationships between the community and the church.

Food and Lodging:

Your team will be staying in a local missionary's home, a mission guest house or a hotel. While there, food will be prepared for your group by the local people. The food will consist of food common to the region.

Transportation and Airfare:

YMI will arrange all of your transportation in country during your trip as it is included in the trip price. We can also add professionally arranged airfare, at cost, to your trip package. We recommend flying into Dublin International Airport.

Visa & Passport:

Each member of your team will need to possess a passport that will be valid at least 9 months after the date you enter the country. No visa is required to enter the country.
